# Rainbow Children's Hospital Launches "Rainbow Mother's Milk Bank" in Vijayawada

**05** August, **2025**, Vijayawada, India; – Rainbow Children's Hospital, Vijayawada, has launched the Rainbow Mother's Milk Bank on the occasion of World Breastfeeding Week. The facility was inaugurated by Smt. KGV Saritha, Deputy Commissioner of Police, NTR District.

The Milk Bank is a critical initiative aimed at providing safe, pasteurised donor milk to premature and critically ill new-borns admitted to the hospital's Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU). Breast milk is especially vital for vulnerable infants, helping prevent infections and improving survival outcomes when the mother's own milk is unavailable.

At the Vijayawada unit, the milk bank has a current storage capacity of **500 litres**. While the volume of milk processed varies depending on clinical requirements, the facility is fully equipped with the **Feed Right** pasteurisation machine and is managed by a team of neonatologists, trained nurses, and lactation consultants. The unit operates in line with IAP-IYCF guidelines, ensuring safe and high-quality handling of donor milk at every stage.

Approximately **50 percent** of preterm babies admitted to the NICU typically require donor milk. So far, over **100 babies** have benefitted from this life-saving support in Vijayawada, thanks to the generosity of nearly **50 mothers** who have donated their breast milk.

Speaking on the launch **Dr Ram Prasad – Neonatologist, Medical Director, Rainbow Children's Hospital, Vijayawada said** "Mother's milk is nothing short of medicine for premature and critically ill newborns. Many of our NICU babies rely on it for survival and recovery. Through this initiative, we aim to ensure that every baby in need receives donor milk—completely free of cost—and gets the best possible start to life."

**Dr Vamsi Sivaramaraju, Neonatologist, Paediatrician, Rainbow Children's Hospital, Vijayawada** said, "This is a truly special moment for all of us. As a neonatologist, I believe a milk bank is nothing short of a miracle. At Rainbow Children's Hospital, we are trained to care for premature babies, often in critical condition, and in many ways, we work against nature to give them a chance at life. In such times, our strongest support is mother's milk. Earlier, there was just one centralised milk bank that provided donor milk, often at a cost many families could not afford. With this initiative, we hope to fulfil our purpose by reaching more new-borns and providing safe, pasteurised breast milk completely free of cost to those who need it most."
